Attached to the email, please include an anonymized abstract of 500 to 750 words (in .doc, .docx, or .pdf form) describing both the focus of your presentation and what you hope the audience will take away from your presentation. The organizing committee will select 2–4 participants for the session by late September and will aim to assemble a panel that is diverse in many respects, including career stage and institutional affiliation.
